- Deposit of TDS on salaries with Govt Generate challan and retain it for filing quarterly returns
- **15**th
- Monthly EPF-ECR TXT file
- Monthly ESIC-ECR excel file

EVERY QUARTER [JAN, APR/MAY, JULY, OCT]

- **15**th
- Quarterly return with Local
 Employment Exchange for the quarter ended
- **31**st
- e-TDS statements to be filed for quarterly income tax returns (Form 24Q)

ANNUALLY [JANUARY]

- **31**st
- III Rule 21(4A), with Inspector under whom the area is in command
- The Factories Act, 1948, Inspector under whom the area is in command
- The Payment of Wages Act 1936 & Related Mines Rules, with concerned labour commissioner
